Battle Won showed an affinity for the Del Mar strip last summer, running second in this event after dueling through fast fractions. The six-year-old gelding shipped west once again after finishing fifth behind **Trickey Trevor** in the May 6 Gil Churchill Downs H., but was outfinished in the July 2 GI Triple Bend BC H., running second after his jockey lost the whip. He has been working smartly at Del Mar for this test. **Carthage** has been over the Del Mar main track once before, beating \$32,000 claimers last September. Haltered that day, the gray has won seven-of-10 for his new connections. He bested champion **Lost in the Fog** in the Apr. 22 Golden Gate Sprint and earned his fourth straight score last time out, wiring the field in the June 4 Gill Bay Meadows BC Sprint H. to take it by a length over **Trickey Trevor**. **Bordonaro** also rides a four-race winning streak into this test. He has not been out since capturing the Apr. 13 Gill Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn, but dashed off six furlongs in a sparkling 1:10 flat in his penultimate prep at Santa Anita July 13.
